

I have just received and read with pleasure your kind letter of the 7th August as also the reprints of your papers you have been so good as to send me.

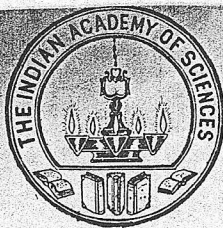
